

## What to Bring from Home



### **Food.**

We require you bring your pets own food to maintain their regular diet. Our regular feeding schedule is twice daily once in the morning and once late afternoon. However, this can easily be adjusted to your pets schedule. Refrigeration is provided for canned food and any special meals. When packing for your pets stay please measure an approximate amount of food they will need. An ice-cream pail, empty coffee container, or Ziploc bag work fine. Our storage space is limited, and large bags or containers are not necessary for short stays, thank you. ☺ Pre-measured individual meals are a real time saver and really appreciated.



### **Medications.**

There is no additional cost for administering medications. Please provide a description of your pets ailment, dosage, and other special needs and instructions for administering meds to insure proper treatment. If you have meds; if you could be so kind as to pre-measure and package individual meals. PLEASE make sure you inform us if you have included medication and provide us with appropriate information regarding that medication(s).



### **Comforts.**

All pets are provided with raised cots in their rooms, Pup North has plenty of cozy blankets and such. However, you are welcome to bring your pets favorite blanket or bed. Toys and Treats are OK. Regarding treats, bring treats you know your dog has had before to prevent any tummy upsets. Save the “special” “I’m sorry I left you” treats for when you get home. Treats and toys are restricted to your pets own room for their comfort and enjoyment, please be advised if you have include rawhides they may not necessarily be supervised while chewing on them.
